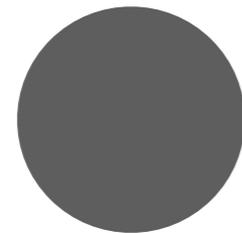

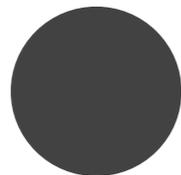
market size

value proposition

1. Transcriber.wiki saves **a lot of time**:

▶ **BEFORE** TRANSCRIBER:

- search Apple Podcasts; and then
- search YouTube; and then
- search CSPAN; and then

✓ *SEARCH THE WORLDS SPEECH*

▶ **BEFORE** TRANSCRIBER:

- listen to a 2 hour podcast (**2 hours**)

✓ *AFTER TRANSCRIBER:*

- skim / speed read / key word search 2 hour podcast (**2 - 3 minutes**)

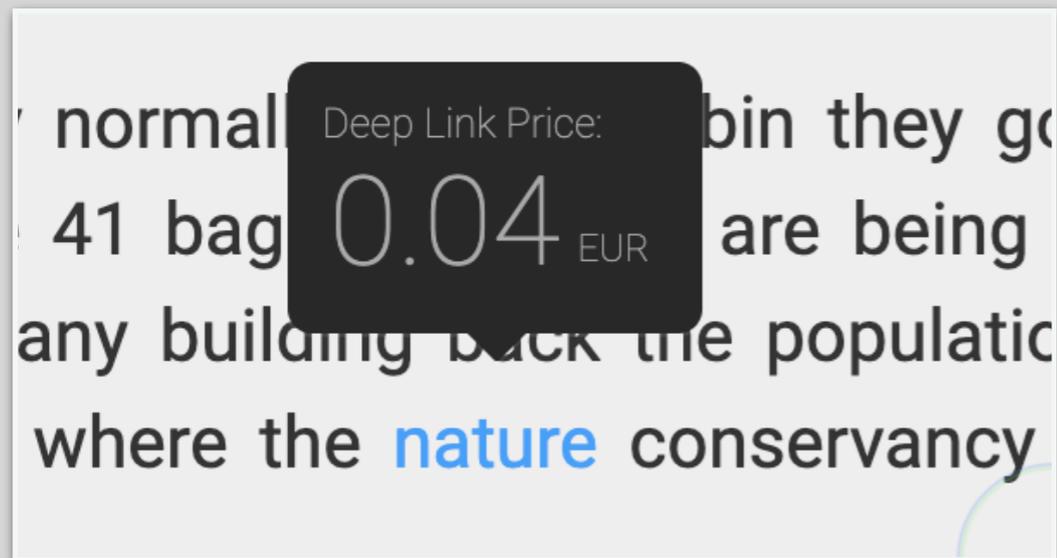

- ✓ **\$0.01 - \$0.99:** dynamic micropayments per deep link *



- * users pay "micropayments per deep link" for the time-saving convenience of skipping directly to specific key words within the transcribed audio / video.

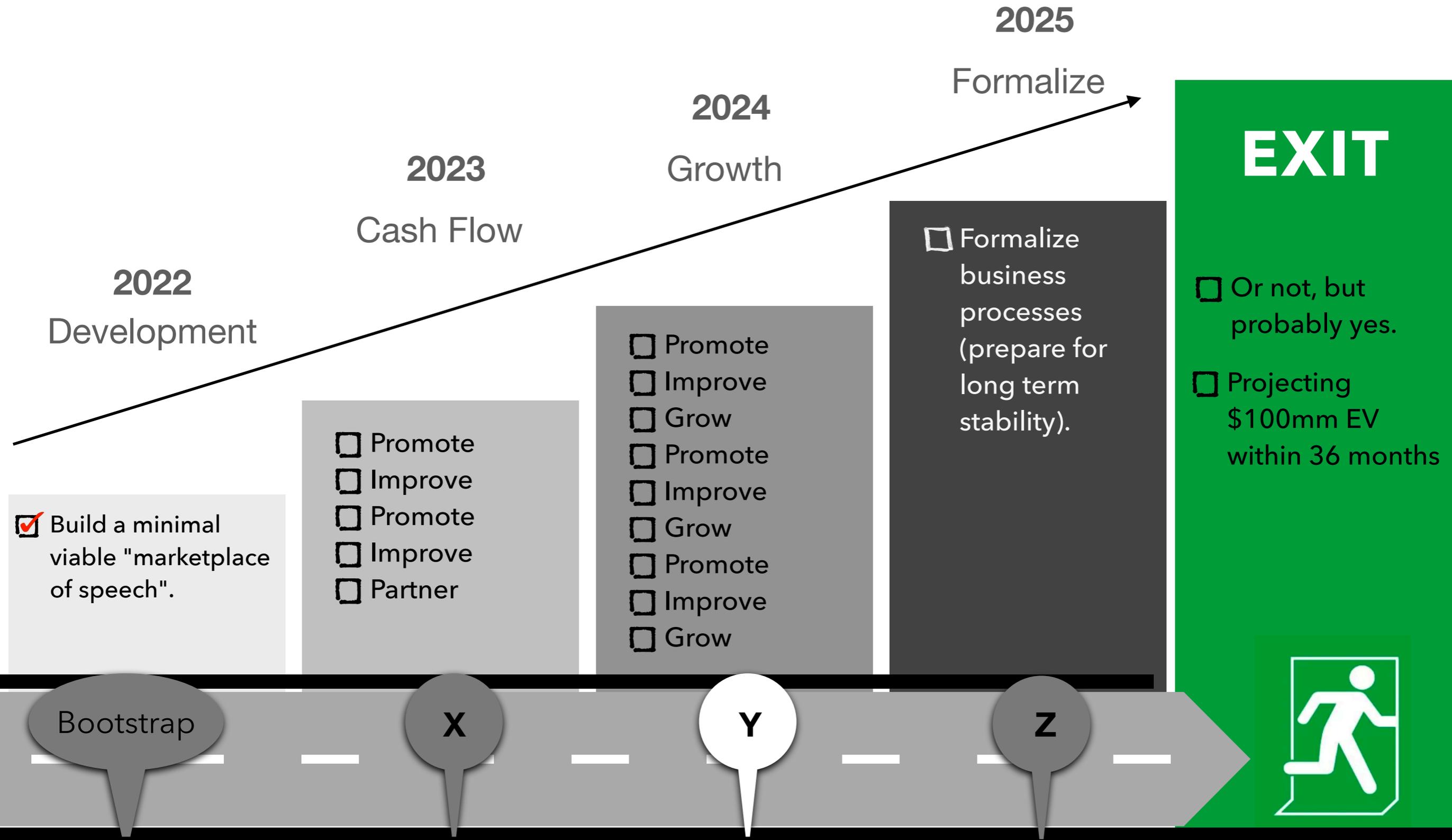

- ✓ Serving humanity as an "archive of speech" service, transcriber.wiki maintains a growing database of "exclusive" content that is no longer available at its source (*due to censorship, storage costs, etc.*).
- ✓ Network effects.
